1. Introduction

- 1.1 dunnhumby Sphere (the "Platform") is owned and operated by dunnhumby Limited ("dunnhumby", "we", "us" or "our").
- 1.2 Our Cookie Notice explains:
 - how we use cookies and similar technologies ("cookies") to recognise you when you visit and use the Platform; and
 - the cookies we use, why we use them and how you can control our use of cookies.

3. What are cookies?

Overview

- 3.1 Cookies are small text files which are placed and stored on your computer, mobile or other device when you first visit a website. We use cookies to help the Platform work effectively and efficiently.
- 3.2 We also use a technology similar to cookies called LocalStorage to remember your selected preferences when using the Platform. LocalStorage is an industry-standard technology that allows a website to store information locally on your computer, mobile or other device.
- 3.3 For the purposes of this notice, the term 'cookies' also refers to LocalStorage.

Types of cookies

3.4 Source of cookies

- First party cookies cookies we set on the Platform.
- Third party cookies cookies set by other companies (including, our group companies) on the Platform.

3.5 Categories of cookies

- Essential cookies cookies that are essential for operation, and your use, of the Platform.
- Performance cookies cookies that help us to recognise you and improve the functionality of the Platform.
- Analytical cookies cookies that collect information about your use of the Platform and monitor the performance of the Platform to help us improve performance, the services we provide to you through the Platform and your experience of using it.

3.6 Duration of cookies

- Session cookies cookies that start working when you access the Platform and stop when you log-out.
- **Persistent cookies** cookies that stay in one of your browser's subfolders until your browser deletes them (based on the duration period of the cookie) or you manually delete them.

4. How we use cookies

We use the following cookies in the Platform:

5. How to control and delete cookies

- 5.1 You can control and delete cookies as follows:
 - at any time you can amend the settings of your internet browser (<u>Google Chrome</u>, <u>Microsoft Internet Explorer</u> and <u>Mozilla Firefox</u>) to choose whether or not to accept cookies. You can also use the settings in your internet browser to delete cookies which have already been set, for example by clearing your browser cache;
 - when we need to obtain your consent to store cookies on your devices for non-essential cookies, we will request this and if you do not consent to cookies we will not use these cookies.
- 5.2 Please note that some the Platform functionality may not be available to you if you restrict or disable cookies.

6. Changes to this Cookie Notice

We will update our Cookie Notice from time to time, and when we do, we will post the updated version on the Platform. The current version of our Cookie Notice is the version available through the link on the Platform and the current version replaces all previous versions.
